

The Alexandria Gun Club held its Annual Pistol League Awards night and Membership meeting on April 3, 2018.

The meeting was called to order by President Brian Armstrong who then led the membership in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Awards were presented prior to the membership meeting.

No officer reports at this meeting.

Old Business:

- Purchase of a handicapped accessible porta potty for the outdoor range was discussed. We don't have solid figures on this yet. The membership had voted at the January annual meeting to move forward with this item at a cost no more than \$2000. However, no one knew numbers at that time. We will bring more information to membership as we learn more.
- Cost of purchasing a new or used locked outdoor storage shed for the range was discussed. This item was approved at the January membership meeting. Motions were made to purchase the new versus the used shed. Membership voted and approved.
- Purchase of shooting stalls for the pistol outdoor range was discussed. Member Mike Townsend brought in some diagrams for membership to review. He will bring findings on cost associated to our spring meeting/clean up at the outdoor range.
- AGC purchased bulk hearing and eye protection (approved at the Jan meeting) and will get that to the outdoor range as soon as the weather clears up a bit. These items will be available for member events at the range.

New Business:

- Membership voted and approved a \$500 donation to the Alexandria Area Youth Trap League.
- E911 address has been created for the outdoor range. Signage will be developed with this information so that if an event occurs at the range, we will be able to get assistance quickly. The new E911 address signs will go up this summer but law enforcement does have it on file. **Please do NOT mail anything to this address.** It is for location purposes only. The address is 18550 Co Rd 12 NW, Garfield, MN.
- A Range Rules Committee was formed at the meeting. Clayton Borstad, Jim Lee, Rich Merten, Brian Armstrong, Kim Roering, Judi Anderson, and Mike Townsend will be meeting to review and create these documents. - Summer Events : Brian Armstrong discussed trying out a small Rimfire Challenge or other challenges at the range. - Fall Pistol league dates have not been set yet but there was discussion that they could go just in Oct or Oct into Nov. Membership will need to decide on that this summer.
