The Alexandria Gun Club held its annual meeting at the Corral in Nelson, MN on Tuesday, January 04, 2022. New applications and dues were collected prior to and after the meeting.

The meeting was started with President Brian Armstrong leading the club in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Officer Reports followed.

Secretary Kim Roering reviewed the minutes from the previous annual meeting. Minutes can be viewed on our website as well.

Treasurer Jim Lee provided the treasury report and had the financials available for review. This information will not be posted in minutes as they are shared on line. Any member interested in these balances may contact the Treasurer for a meeting.

Three board members were up for renew this year: Rich Merten, Sam Miller and Rod Schultz. Merten & Schultz were re-elected for another 3-year term. Miller stepped down and new board member Mike Townsend was elected to the board. All motions were seconded and approval by membership.

Pistol League will be allowed at the ATCC beginning on 01/11/22. This will be a twelve-week league with flyers to be sent to membership with dates/times. COVID regulations were discussed and will be in the information going out this week.

Old Business:

- The porta potty will continue to be maintained monthly during the months of May-November 2022.
- Range rules and keeping the range in good maintenance was reviewed and flyers with Range Safety rules were available at the meeting.
- Sight in Days will be established closer to the event but for the past two years have been 1 weekend prior to the early season and 1 weekend prior to opener.
- Cameras at the range were discussed based on last year's suggestion to look into what the trap range is using. These cameras were not as effective as previously hoped. No further discussion.
- Doors were put on the Pistol range shed to help prevent snow from accumulating in that shed and keep members warmer.

New Business:

- Announcement to membership that Central Specialties has not purchased the gravel pit where our range is located. They have agreed to maintain our lease at this time. The club has paid for the lease for the year and submitted proof of insurance documents to CSI.
- Discussion to re-stack the berms when we are out cleaning the range this spring.
- Range cleanup date was set with a tentative date of May 7, 2022.
- The club voted to put a floor in the new 100-yard range shed prior to building out on the front of it.
- Membership voted to donate \$1000 to the Alexandria Area Youth Trap Range. Motions began at \$500, and were raised to \$750 before amending to \$1000 and being voted and approved by membership. A check will be mailed to the AAYTA.

- Pistol League – will begin on 1/11. See flyer on website.

Membership gate code will be changed at the end of January.
