



Lowey Products recommends the “Hopwell Method” for tuning your Lowey Barrel Tuner. Using this method, You will locate the "optimum" spot of your rifle barrel (and the specific ammo you are using).

1. Set your tuner weight at the beginning and fire five shots.
2. Turn the tuner weight one complete revolution and fire another five shots, continue this and you will find the group size decreasing.
** Shift to a different POA for each group. (Don't mix groups)
3. When you fire a group that appears to have increased, turn the tuner weight back $\frac{1}{4}$ turn and fire another five shots.
4. Then turn it back another $\frac{1}{4}$ turn, firing another five shots. (the object is to find the setting that yields the smallest groups)
5. You may need to go another $\frac{1}{4}$ turn, but you may also need to go back an $\frac{1}{8}$ of a turn to find your “optimum” setting for your tuner.

If you have any doubts – please restart at Step 1.

Once you find the optimum setting for your barrel and the ammo – please note it down for future reference.

You will need to recheck this setting when you change batches of ammo.

You may decide to start off firing only 2-3 shots to set your group – this is your decision.
